



W070 - Facilities Management and Maintenance

W070 Task Group 2 is engaged in formulating an international research agenda. As the first step Dr. Keith Jones from the University of Greenwich, United Kingdom is surveying the active members of the Commission for assistance in identifying current issues in Building Maintenance / Property Management which require the attention of the research community.

Following an analysis of the results, a summary list of issues will be compiled. This will be recirculated with the request to rank the issues in order of importance to the recipient's organisation and country of residence.

To broaden the input base, the invitation is made to those in the wider circle of the CIB Membership who are in a position to do so to reply to the first Questionnaire. A realistic international research agenda is a singularly useful tool in devising a meaningful work programme for any Commission or Task Group.

The Questionnaire is simple in design and seeks to elicit information on research issues/projects divided into 4 sections.

- Building Maintenance/Property Management issues of interest to your organisation (expand as necessary)
- Building Maintenance/Property Management issues of interest in your country of residence (expand as necessary)
- Details of current Building Maintenance/Property Management research projects you are involved with (expand as necessary)
- Details of current Building Maintenance/Property Management research projects you are aware of in your country of residence (expand as necessary)

He emphasises that information will be treated in confidence and will not be disseminated in an attributable form. (However, respondents should ensure that their Name, Organisation and Country are included on their reply.)
