The organisers of the CIB W062 2003 International Symposium strongly encourage and welcome participation by delegates from all over the world. Our technical sessions and program items will offer you a rewarding opportunity for learning and networking with professional colleagues engaged in all aspects of water supply and drainage systems for the built environment.





Symposium Objectives

The symposium will mainly focus on experiences, research, innovations and knowledge, which is applicable or relevant to water supply and drainage systems in buildings. The major objectives of the symposium are:

- to report on the most recent developments and advance in the field;
- to discuss the application of research results in real buildings;
- to provide a forum where researchers, engineers, architects, and practitioners can analyse productive and constructive approaches to the future development and implementation of codes and standards;
- to promote international co-operative research in this area.

Problems deserving of special attention are considered to be:

- use of new materials,
- interactions between pipe material and drinking water,
- specific problems in high rise buildings,
- installations for disabled people,
- software for design,
- maintenance, improvement and reconstruction of water supply and drainage systems,
- specific problems in historical buildings.
- use of non-destructive technologies for assessment and rehabilitation.
- precautions against flooding.
- water supply and drainage protection in earthquake design.

Topics

Within the general area of concern, i.e. water supply (cold and hot) and drainage (waste and rainwater) for buildings, papers specifically addressing the following topics are encouraged:

- Performance of building materials and systems: durability, effect on water quality, comfort, costs,
- Sustainable construction: water conservation, life cycle analysis, individual waste water treatment
- Standardisation and certification
- Dimensioning, calculation methods, analysis and solutions
- Modelling systems
- Water transport phenomena in porous materials
- Innovative industrial developments,
- Assessing and innovating systems

Call For Papers

Authors are invited to submit an abstract (not exceeding 300 words) for consideration by the scientific committee, together with the personal data required on the registration form.

All abstracts must be in English and sent by e-mail to the symposium secretariat, cibw62@metu.edu.tr, before March 31, 2003. Please do not fax the abstracts!

The proceedings will be published in English and will contain all papers presented during the symposium.
