Around the Task Groups and Working Commissions

Recent Changes in the Programme of Task Groups and Working Commissions

At its meeting on 14 March in Ankara Turkey the CIB Programme Committee confirmed the following terminations, upgrades and establishments of New CIB Task Groups and Working Commissions.

- Upgrading of former TG51 – Usability of Workplaces into CIB Working Commission W111 – Usability of Workplaces
- Termination of TG52 - Transport and the Built Environment
- Termination of TG60 - Critical Infrastructure Protection
- New established is TG64 – Disasters and the Built Environment (provisional title)
- Termination of W082 – Futures Studies in Construction.

The new Task Groups and Working Commissions will be introduced in detail in the 4th CIB Newsletter in April 2006.

Current attached Table an updated overview is given of all CIB Task Groups and Working Commissions with an indication of their potential relevance to the four CIB Priority Themes and of their assumed contribution to the CIB Areas of Scientific Interest.

As concerns the relationship of the CIB Task Groups and Working Commissions to the fourth Priority Theme: IDS – Integrated Design Solutions, it must be stated that at this stage of development these are provisional only as this theme is still under development.
