9th REHVA World Congress



Introduction

The 9th REHVA World Congress 'CLIMA2007', co-sponsored by CIB will take place in Helsinki, Finland on 10-14 June 2007. The congress offers scientists, industry, building owners, consultants, engineers, architects and policy-makers a platform for the exchange of scientific knowledge and technical solutions.

The Congress is co-organised by:
FINVAC – The Finnish Association of HVAC Societies and
FAMBSI - The Finnish Association of Mechanical Building Services Industries.

The scope of the Congress is HVAC and its applications in creating wellbeing in indoor environments in an environmentally sustainable manner in all types of buildings.

Themes and Topics

- Healthy and productive indoor climate
- Comfort and safety by modern piping systems
- Sustainable energy use of buildings
- Intelligent building management

The technical programme will contain:

- Keynote sessions with eminent speakers from the academic community and the HVAC industry.
- Scientific sessions with full technical papers and oral and poster presentations on recent research results.

- Practical sessions with short technical communications and poster presentations on practical applications of HVAC technology.
- Pre-planned REHVA-workshops on concurrent problems and international possibilities for solving them.

Call for Papers

The organizers invite abstracts of scientific papers and technical communications by **15 Oct 2006**. The abstract should not exceed 300 words and it should not contain illustrations.

There will be two types of papers in the CLIMA 2007 Congress. Papers reporting scientific work within the scope of the Congress will be reviewed and printed in the Proceedings. The length of these papers is 6-8 pages. The Proceeding will be distributed to all Congress participants as a CD-ROM and an abstract book. Printed copies of the Proceedings will be made available at extra cost. After the event, the abstracts will also be available at the Congress web service and later also at AIVC's bibliographic database Airbase. Scientific papers will be presented during the Congress in oral and poster presentation sessions.

Congress Venue

The congress will take place in Finlandia Hall, the leading concert and congress venue in Finland. Centrally placed yet set amid park-like surroundings, it is an excellent environment for concerts, conferences and exhibitions. These are flexible meeting spaces from plenary sessions and social events with up to 1500 participants to workshops, small group meetings

and poster exhibitions. All spaces are located close to each other and have state-of-the-art audiovisual equipment.



The location of the Venue within walking distance from hotels and the city centre of Helsinki give the delegates and their spouses maximal flexibility in planning their program during the Conference.
