These are the Proceedings from CIB W092 Symposium on Sustainability and Value Through Construction Procurement held from 29 November - 2 December 2006 in Salford, UK. This Symposium brought together researchers and practitioners from many parts of the world to share their research, knowledge and experience concerning construction procurement. All of the papers have been selected on the basis of strict review by the Scientific Committee members to ensure a high standard.
