Overview December 2007

The year 2007 ended with 17 Task Groups and 35 Working Commissions.

One Task Group ended its activities:

- TG33-Collaborative Engineering

Four new Task Groups have been established last year:

- TG67 - Statutory Adjudication in Construction,
- TG68 - Construction Mediation,
- TG69 - Green Buildings and the Law,
- TG70 - Sustainable Design of Tall Buildings
former TG50 - Tall Buildings.

Three Working Commissions stopped their activities:

- W105 - Life Time Engineering in Construction,
- W106 - Geographical Information Systems,
- W109 - Ecospace.

Two new Working Commissions were set up:

- W115 - Construction Materials Stewardship,
former TG39 - Deconstruction and
- W116 Smart and Sustainable Built Environments
former TG55 - Smart and Sustainable Built
Environments.

In the table shown hereafter an overview is given of CIB's Task Groups and Working Commissions as per June 2007. For each commission and indication is given of the extend to which it is expected to contribute to the defined CIB Priority Themes SC - Sustainable Construction, CU - Clients and Users, RC - Revaluing Construction, IDS - Integrated Design Solutions and also of the extend to which is thought to be of importance to defined Areas of Scientific Interest.
