Introduction

The University of Zagreb, Faculty of Civil Engineering is organizing Joint International Symposium of CIB Working Commissions W055 - Building Economics and W065 - Organization and Management in Construction. This is the prominent annual meeting hosting the best researchers, consultants, managers and experts from the fields of organization, management, and economy in construction.

The theme of the symposium is "CONSTRUCTION FACING WORLDWIDE CHALLENGES".

The goal is to present and exchange experience in the international construction sector.
