Aim

Architecture can be viewed as a kind of integrated applied science that encompasses several sectors such as engineering, technology, management and art. This symposium will cover various topics starting with future trends in architectural management, and its combination with government policy, construction practices, environment control, planning, design, architectural history and theory.

The symposium aims to discover applications of architectural management in the past, to discuss the present worldwide condition of architectural management as well as to anticipate and to plan for the future role of architectural management. The

symposium will serve as a meeting ground of experts from around the world and will be an opportunity for them to share their experiences, problems and the solutions they have responded with, especially the solutions utilizing state-of-the-art technology.

Symposium Themes

The Symposium will address the following architectural management themes:

- Sustainable architectural design management and public policy
- Integrated design – the changing role of AEC organisations
- BIM, ICTs and the management of architectural design

- Management, preservation and reconstruction of historical buildings
- Influence of new construction contracts on the architect's role and design value
- Emergent management paradigms in Architectural Management
- Applications of architectural environment control and management technologies

Submission Schedule

Abstracts should be written in English, and not be more than 250 words. The abstract should clearly state the nature of the contribution and identify the status of the work being reported. Full papers should be 10 pages maximum. All submissions of interest/abstracts should be sent by E-mail, as an MS Word attachment, to Dr. Chun-Ta Tzeng ctmt@mail.ncku.edu.tw before the deadline. Please remember to include your correct email address, postal address, and affiliation.
