13-24 July 2009, Beijing, China

"Tsinghua summer school for international construction and property 2009: Institutions and Management Practices in China", which is a two week intensive training program, will be held on 13-24th July 2009 and targets audiences that include industry practitioners, final year undergraduate students, and postgraduate students by coursework or research from around the globe who are keen to understand the institutional environment and best practices to implement architecture, engineering, construction, and development projects in China.

This is the second year for the non-profit-making program to be held. This year, over 100 students will benefit from taking the summer school program. The instructors will be from different organizations with various educational and professional backgrounds, including university professors (both local and overseas), government officials, AEC firm managers (both local and overseas), client organization representatives, lawyers, and consultants. Moreover, the students will visit the landmark projects in Beijing including the Olympic venues, the new CCTV headquarters building, and Beijing Capital International Airport Terminal 3. In the mean time students from different countries will have a chance to interact with Chinese students, professors, government officials and industry practitioners. A visit

to Shanghai is an optional module following the program based in Beijing.

Upon completion of the program, the students will be granted a Certificate of Tsinghua Summer School for International Construction and Property 2009 in both English and Chinese issued by Tsinghua University.

Who Should Attend

Industry practitioners, final year undergraduate students, and postgraduate students by coursework or research from around the globe who are keen to understand the institutional environment and best practices to implement architecture, engineering, construction, and development projects in China can benefit from taking this program.

Certificate

Upon completion of the training program, a student will be granted a Certificate of Tsinghua Summer School for International Construction and Property - Succeed in China: Institutions and Management Practices in both English and Chinese issued by Tsinghua University.

Language

The entire program will be delivered in English.

Registration

To register please contact the Program Coordinator, Dr. Chuan Chen or the Program Manager, Mr. Fan Wu or Assistant Julia Zhu. The deadline for registration is **June 30, 2009**.

The normal registration fee is CNY¥4200 (around US\$615) for students, and CNY¥7000 (around US\$1025) for industry practitioners.

CIB Members who want to attend the summer school will be offered 20% off discount on the basis of CNY¥4200, that means the registration fee for CIB members is CNY¥3360 (around US\$492).

The fee does not include accommodation. If needed, we can help to arrange campus accommodation (fully furnished room with air-con, internet connection, and basic electric appliances) and help to apply for campus canteen card at participants' expenses. The average charge is CNY¥150 (around US\$22) per person per day for accommodation and CNY¥20 (around US\$3) for dinning.
