

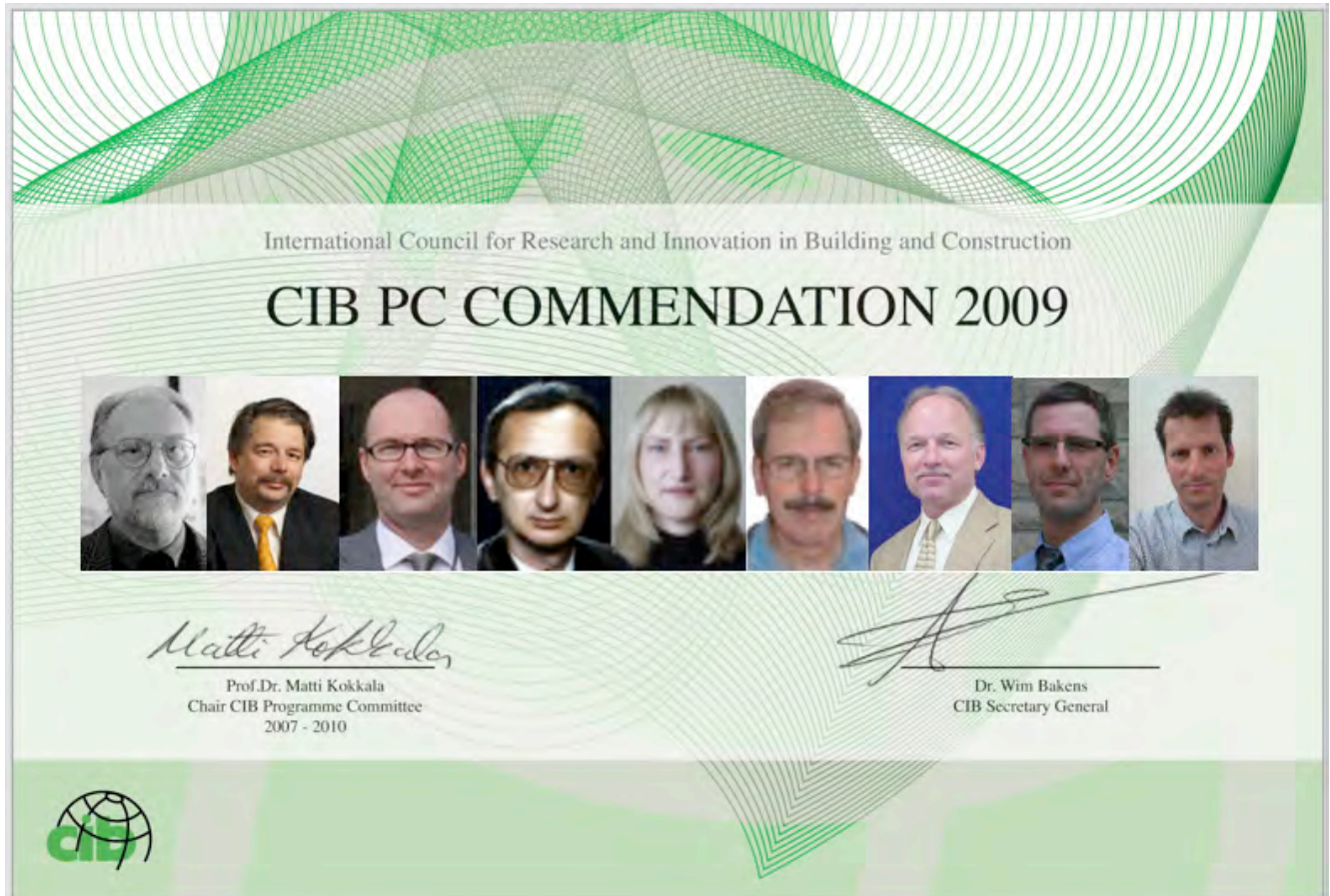

The CIB Programme Committee awards the annual PC Commendations for extra ordinary performance in the CIB Programme of Activities for 2009.

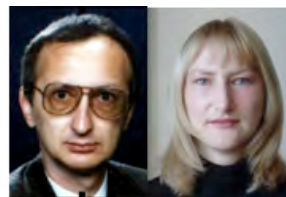
