## Overview CIB Task Groups and Working Commissions

### Developments 2009

The year 2009 ended with 19 Task Groups and 35 Working Commissions.

Two Task Group ended their activities in 2009:

- TG49 - Architectural Engineering
- TG56 - Macroeconomics for Construction (merged into W055 - Building Economics)

One new Task Group has been established last year:

- TG77 - Health and the Built Environment

In addition in January 2009 a Task Group was upgraded into a Working Commission:

- TG61 - Benchmarking Construction Performance Data

became

- W117 - Performance Measurement in Construction

The Working Commission was established in January 2009 as successor to the former CIB Task Group TG61 on Benchmarking Construction Performance Data.

In the table shown hereafter an overview is given of CIB's Task Groups and Working Commissions as per December 2009. For each commission and indication is given of the extend to which it is expected to contribute to the defined CIB Priority Themes: SC - Sustainable Construction, CU - Clients and Users, RC - Revaluing Construction and IDDS - Integrated Design and Delivery Solutions and also of the extend to which it is thought to be of importance to defined Areas of Scientific Interest.
