

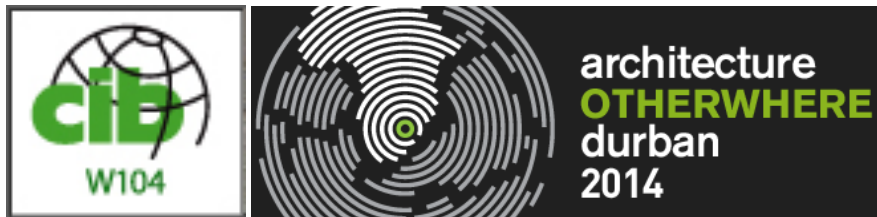

W104 - Open Building Implementation

Call for Papers for the CIB W104 Sessions



to be held in conjunction with the XXV IUA World Congress,

“architecture OTHERWHERE - Resilience, Ecology, Values”

3-7 August 2014 in Durban, South Africa

The organisers are pleased to receive paper proposals in the following seven topics:

- Reactivation of the existing building stock for sustainability and long term value – including base building and cladding upgrades, and infill or fit-out refurbishment
- Planning and decision-making strategies for healthcare facilities for long life under conditions of change
- Planning new housing for long term value under changing social and economic conditions
- Open building applied to post-disaster reconstruction – resiliency and variety in respect to evolving life-style and economic conditions
- Incremental social housing
- Research into principles of long-lived ordinary buildings as part of architectural history
- The dimension of time and people in the reform of architectural pedagogy

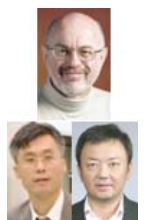
