During the period 1992 - 1994 an analysis was undertaken into the existing organisation of the Building Process. Trends in the development and implementation of process improvement and prevailing ideas on future perspectives for alternative models for organising the Building Process were looked at in the following countries: Sweden, Finland, Denmark, the UK, the Netherlands, Belgium, France, Italy, Canada and the USA.

Based on these National Analyses, International Analyses were made of those Development Themes that proved to be dominant in the various Building and Construction R&D Programmes in all or almost all of the Countries and International Future Scenarios for Building Process Organisation were developed.
