# Mr. Bill Cullen

Just as we are going to press with this issue, W83 Coordinator Walter J. Rossiter Jr. has informed us that Bill Cullen died of cancer at this home on 5th November 1997.

Writes Walt Rossiter:

"Bill had a long and illustrious career first with the US National Bureau of Standards (now the National Institute of Standards and Technology) and then with National Roofing Contractors Association. For 50 years, he worked continuously for improved roofing performance.

Our longstanding members know Bill as the founder of the Joint CIB/RILEM Roofing Committee in 1982. When initiated, the Committee was designated as the CIB/RILEM Joint Committee on Single-Layer Roofing. It was subsequently renamed as the CIB/RILEM Joint Committee on Elastomeric, Thermoplastic and Polymer Modified Bituminous Roof Systems. As the Committee and its activities evolved over the years, Bill continued to work with us as an active member.

We will long remember his many contributions not only to the Committee, but also to the international roofing community."
