

Election of New Officers and Board 1998-2001

The 16th General Assembly

11th June 1998

Document 16-4(98)

To be discussed as Agenda Item 6

The outgoing Board has put forward 23 candidates for election as an Officer or Board Member for the forthcoming Triennium 1998-2001.

The fact that the current maximum number of Board Members is 25 means that two more candidates can either be coopted by the new Board or elected by the General Assembly.

The nominations that are listed below are those that were circulated to Full Members earlier and within the prescribed period.

Although almost all the candidates have communicated their willingness to serve if elected, confirmation is still awaited from one or two.

The definitive list will of course be announced at the General Assembly.

According to the current CIB By-Laws it is the task of the retiring Board to submit nominations for the new Board to the General Assembly.

The outgoing Board has recommended that the General Assembly should elect the following 23 candidates as an Officer or Board Member for the Triennium 1998 - 2001.

It should be noted that, according to the proposed amended Constitution, the Chairman of the CIB Programme Committee will henceforth be an Officer.

Mr. Larry Little who is proposed for election as a Board Member has indicated his willingness to assume this function, if he is elected to the Board.

To date 4 candidates have been lawfully nominated but they are not included on the list of recommendations. They are also listed below.

The current maximum number of Board Members is 25 so that two seats remain which can be filled either through cooption by the new Board or through election by the General Assembly.

Another proposed amendment to the Constitution increases the number of Associate Members eligible for the Board to six and so both of these two seats can be filled by Associate Members.
